Evaluation criteria	Exemplary questions
Relevance	Are the project goals, concepts, strategies and activities consistent?
	Are they adequate in relation to the country / community environment and regarding the cultural practices around FGM?
	Are the project activities relevant to achieve a significant impact among the communities and key professionals?
	Are the selected change agents able to ensure the success of the project?
Effectiveness	Are project materials (e.g. prevention brochure, website, training manual) effective to achieve the project objectives (community dialogue, reduction of social/ cultural pressures, behavioural change, end of stigmatization)?
	Are the project materials and activities culturally sensitive and gender sensitive?
	Have project objectives been achieved, or will they be likely to be achieved over the course of the project?
	What are the factors of success, what are the challenges in the project implementation and framework conditions?
Efficiency	Are project resources spent in ways that bring about the project objectives?
	Are spending patterns within the project commensurate with project goals?
	Are activities organized so that resources are used optimally?
Impact	Which positive or negative, intended or unintended impacts does the project achieve?
	What is the projects contribution to the elimination of FGM in Europe?
	Does the project contribute to empowering women and girls in the affected communities?
	What are the project's side effects (e.g. in the communities, among key professionals, among project partners, and in societies)?
Sustainability and transfer	To what extent are the project's impacts sustainable?
	Is the organizational structure of the overall project conducive to sustain the project's impacts?
	Is the material (e.g. training manual) like to be used by other NGOs? Have others expressed their interest already?
	Which other factors impact the sustainability and transferability of project results?
Comparison between project implementation plan and reality	Is the project implementation according to plan, both in qualitative and quantitative measures?
	What are the reasons for disparities? Is it necessary to change the plan?
