Plan International Mali

- Focus on child protection, especially the abandonment of FGM
- Working together with village chiefs and local mayors to run a widespread campaign against FGM
- Results so far: 45 village chiefs and 18 mayors publically signed a commitment to abandon the practice in their areas

Promoting behaviour change

CHANGE

- Main focus on FGM
- Running campaigns for the abandonment of FGM, working together with local chiefs, training of selected multipliers such as teachers, midwifes, excisors, then building a village committee that continues the work
- Results so far: FGM village committees in more than 820 villages, 400 excisors gave up their profession, now supporting the campaign and raising awareness

 - 2 within the Leadership training for **CHANGE Champion**


Aim
